An attacker, No.9. has been declared off-side but, before the free-kick is taken, he is pushed by a defender inside the penalty-area. What is the correct action?

12.7.3 SITUATION A: (a) A short goal kick is taken by a teammate and played to his/her goalkeeper standing outside the penalty area so that the goalkeeper plays the ball with his/her feet into the penalty area and picks it up; or (b) a pass to A1 is headed or chested to his/her goalkeeper, who picks the ball up with his/her hands.

- 1. The ball must clear the penalty area on any free kick by the defense within the penalty area. Opponents must remain outside the penalty area until the ball clears the area.

Is there a common denominator?

During a goal kick, the ball is not in play until it has left the penalty area. Opponents must remain outside of the penalty area until the ball clears the penalty area.

If the ball fails to enter the field of play on a throw-in, the ball is awarded to the opponent at the spot of the infraction.

"How long has this been going on?"

Bandanas & knotted items are considered adornment and may be dangerous—they are illegal.

Pre-game responsibilities!

Players are not to remove or swap jerseys at the conclusion of the match (regular season=yellow, tournament=yellow/red)

Officials shall uphold the honor and dignity of the profession in all interaction with student-athletes, coaches, athletic directors, school administrators, colleagues, and the public.


#2 What you say and do will get out.

↓ Mechanics Session ↓

1. Trail → getting the "after" foul after the through ball.
 - (1) You can get the "play-on" (check out situation)
 - (2) A guy/gal on the ground an we don't know why!!

2. The official has the power to stop the clock to assess a possible injury to a player. Using a reasonable amount of time, the official may find the player not injured and thus able to stay in the game.

"Do you want to continue?"

3. What's the call partner? I know there's no signals. Got to at least give a direct/indirect signal, throw-in. Gimme something!

4. That "far side" push as the lead. Trail is way back there!

5. You need to give teams the time. They (the teams) need to know where they stand. (Situation expiration)
