

CCSOA Meeting 9/16/13 Interpreters Program "Space. The Final Frontier."

1. Ball around the 22-25 yard area going right into the L way. T has some blank space all of a sudden. Take it and go off the ball. There can and will be some possible action later on in the play. Did anybody gain advantage before the service? Penalties in the area?
2. L to T. Two passes to the far reaching sideline (same side). You need to get going. It could be a jog or something more. L on other side has plenty to deal with in front of him. You will be passing through both benches. It would be great if you were near the play. It's a tough sale from afar.
3. Same as above but this time ball is on the leads side. So much open area for the trail. Please don't stay with the last FB. You can help in so many ways especially on the crosses coming over in and around the 18.
4. Pinching in as the T because there's no ball play in your area. Take it. Recovery is a straight line remember as opposed to the diagonal retreat. You need to get to the sidelines for the out of bounds call.
5. Getting the leads spots on foul calls as the T. Players and teams that have been offended will try to get as much as they can. Get to the area of concern and say "even with me." It can be initiated by the L or the T.
6. Getting Help/ Giving Help. In your pre-game decide with your partner how you will be communicating these situations when the L or T is unsure who it went off? Is it a corner or a goalkick? Which team should be entitled to the throw? AND OFCOURSE, come in if you have something different. You have to be 100% sure and at least be in a similar area code ☺.
7. Where are you lookin'? Remember when any ball is in flight there could be some major jockeying for position going on down below. Please don't be the "ball watcher." Be a "player watcher."
8. Getting to the endlines when the players and the ball is there as well. Don't assume it's out bounds just because players raise their hands. Goalkicks should be called if the whole ball is over the line. But you need to be there to call it. Or it could be a cornerkick on a quick deflection.
9. Please don't re-start the game while your partner is relaying the information to the bench area on goals scored and assists. Let him or her get back into position and then blow the whistle. What kind of whistle by the way?
10. Throw-ins? It never came in vs. it came in and then left. Proper re-starts and spots.
