

MIAA TOURNAMENT CHEAT SHEET October 2015

Game duration: two 40 minute halves. 10 minute halftime.

Tie-Breaking Procedures:

- Five minute rest period after regulation
- Coin toss is held, same as start of the game.
- *Ten-minute sudden victory overtime period* (15 minute in state final only). Each team is allowed one timeout per overtime period. These cannot be carried over to the next period of play.
- If still tied after first overtime period, *second ten-minute sudden victory overtime period* will be played. Teams will change ends, no break.
- If still tied after second overtime period, move to *kicks from the penalty spot*.
- Review the procedures for this with all coaches, team captains and officials at the halfway line.
- Any player selected for a round of penalty kicks **MAY** be substituted for by the coach **PRIOR TO THEIR TURN**.

Everyone **MUST** review and know the procedures for this tie-breaking method. Discuss them with your crew **PRIOR** to the start of the game so everyone knows their responsibility when and if you get to this point. Know which goal will be used prior to the start of the game. Infringements to watch for during penalty kicks:

*** Goalkeepers moving off their line prior to the ball being in play.

*** Kickers interrupting their movement on the approach to the ball.

- Timeouts: same allowance as in regulation time. The timeout may be called by the coach or any player on the field during their offensive re-start (free kick, goal kick, corner kick, penalty kick, throw-in). Any team can call a timeout after goals, cautions, or disqualifications, after an injury timeout, and at the taking of a dropped ball. **NO TIMEOUTS** are allowed during any set of overtime penalty kicks.
