ASSIGNOR

Ted Cote, Pat Donovan & Keith Forker

The issue of compensation for the Assignors was discussed.

Prior to the 2015 season, after Ted Cote had relinquished the post, the Executive Committee discussed the compensation package for the Assignors in preparation to discussing appointing a new Assignor.

The Exec. Comm. voted to not provide compensation from CCSOA to the Assignors as they were already being paid by the schools (and Pat Donovan if they handled one or more of his schools) for assigning referees. Prior to the vote it was \$7.00/player/assignor.

Ted Cote, raised the issue of the termination of the CCSOA payment. His main points were:

What had changed after 25 years?

What right did the Exec. Comm. have to terminate the compensation?

He felt disrespected by the board doing it without advising him.

President Kiley explained that the Exec. Comm. had come to the decision after learning of his resignation and trying to determine how the next Assignor would be compensated. He advised the members that the Assignors received compensation directly from the schools; no one had any idea how much those contracts were for or how an individual received the contract. He informed the members that the Exec. Comm. was authorized to set policies and procedures for the CCSOA.

Dave DeCarolis told the members that he used to assign for basketball and his contract was only with the schools. He could use any official he could find from whatever group had qualified officials.

Peter Trimble presented a verbal motion to reinstate the fees by over turning the Exec. Comm. decision. Tony Del Negro questioned whether the vote would be constitutional. Mike Paoella inquired as to whether Ted Cote and Keith Forker could be "grandfathered" in and provided compensation.

President Kiley determined that any motions regarding the Assignors compensation would not be entertained as the Exec. Comm. decision was not subject to motions.

INTERPRETER MISOA Rules

Communications with Players

**Do Not Touch Players. Point at them or signal them. DO NOT TOUCH!
Speak with your hands.**

If you are issuing a card, it can be done with the player walking away from you.

Paperwork for cards

Use Score sheet for Yellow or Red.

If Red issued (player or coach), Disqualification Form MUST be filed. MIAA requires IMMEDIATE filing with AD of Home team.

If Coach is Red Carded, rules do require coach to be out for two (2) games even if report not filed.

Whistle Protocol

Remember, Lead has most restart whistles except, kick off, goal kicks, drop balls and throw-ins on side of ref.
