Points of emphasis:

Jewelry absolutely prohibited. No TAPED Ears. Yellow Card to Coach if discovered after match begins. Player substituted for.

EXCEPTION!!! Orange “Twellman bracelet” for concussion awareness. 9/12-9/16

Cause supercedes Rule

**Clock Management: Stopping clock for Injury: All injured players (even Keeper), must leave if clock stopped for injury.  
Coach can play down;  
Next stoppage for injured player  
Next legal stop if substitution**

**Rough Play above Shoulders: Emphasis is to try and reduce injuries, by being on top of play from start of match.**

**Ball Holders: Varsity Coach shall provide. If not, at least extra balls spread around.**

**Discussion re: If a ball is "lost" do we stop the clock. Advise teams that clock will be stopped if all balls have been "lost". Have good communication with 2<sup>nd</sup> Ref, Coaches and Players that clock will be stopped for excessive time wasting**

**Lead/Trail Whistle obligations**

**Trail 1) Kick offs 2) Goal kicks 3 Drop balls.**

**Lead Everything else**

**LOOK AT OTHER REF AND GET EYE CONTACT BE IN SYNC!**

**WAIT A Beat to see if other referee is calling foul.**

#### **CHANGES TO OFF SIDE DETERMINATION**

**MIAA HAS ADDED A "RESET" TO THE OFF SIDE POSITION**

**If a defender makes a DELIBERATE attempt to play the ball and MAKES CONTACT, no matter how slight, the offensive player receiving the ball is no longer to be called for "Off Sides".**

#### **ALL OFFENSIVE PLAYERS IN OFFSIDE POSITION**

|------------------|--|
| <b>Example 1</b> | <b>Defender jumps to head and ball skims head and goes to Offensive player- NO OFFSIDES</b>                                |
| <b>Example 2</b> | <b>Defender jumps to head and ball NOT TOUCHED and goes to Offensive player- OFFSIDES</b>                                  |
| <b>Example 3</b> | <b>Defender, with back to play, is struck by ball and it goes to Offensive player- OFFSIDES.</b>                           |
| <b>Example 4</b> | <b>Goalkeeper attempts to grab throw in by Offensive team and muffs catch, if it goes to Offensive Player- NO OFFSIDES</b> |

**ONLY EXCEPTION TO DELIBERATE CONTACT IS IF DEFENDER (INCLUDING GOALKEEPER) MAKES A DELIBERATE SAVE AND THERE IS A REBOUND TO OFFENSIVE PLAYER IN OFFSIDE POSITION**

**SOFT PADDED HEAD BANDS FOR FIELD PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED**

#### **PENALTY KICKS**

**Kicker is allowed to "stutter step" In approach to take kick**

**Kicker *cannot* stop/start and then kick ball to deceive keeper**

**Carl Zopatti asked "when do I blow whistle if violation." Answer was after the shot taken.**

**If saved and held "Play On".**

If saved and rebound over end-line IFK for Defending team  
If saved or off goal frame and back to kicke or kicker's teammate IFK for  
Defending team  
If Missed "Goal kick".  
If shot goes into net "ReKick".
