INTERPRETER

PROPERLY EQUIPPED:

BEFORE THE START OF THE MATCH,
ALWAYS ASK THE COACHES IF THEIR PLAYERS ARE PROPERLY AND LEGALLY EQUIPPED.

First YC goes to Coach

Second YC goes to Player

Captain Arm Bands on ARM only, not leg

Jewelry/adornments not allowed unless religious/medical and then taped to body.

Shin pad/sock tape or medical tape must be same or similar color

NO MIXUP/ SWITCHING COLORS

PREVENTS THE "ID'ING" OF PLAYERS.

Bob Burt raised the issue of long hair held by bandana with knot and hanging fabric in
A BJV game. NOT ALLOWED

LOUSY FOULS

Bert C. Sent out a very informative video ON TACKLES AND FOULS

BAD FOULS:

From behind

CLEATS UP

Shoves as player goes up for head

Late kicks to legs, etc.

Keys to Call:

Jump on it early

Set tone right away, card if necessary, no "rule" requiring precedent before card

RESTART WHISTLES

BE CONSISTENT!!!!

Lead/trail

Trail only whistles kickoff and Goal Kicks

Quick Restarts

2nd whistle not required unless attacking team asks for 10 yds.

If 10 yds asked for, do not have to step off.

10 yd violations

Tell Captains to tell team 10 yds immediately

Verbal warning FIRST. Do this as quickly as possible to set tone.

YC to first player who delays restart after verbal even if different player

(Persistent Infringement can be a team strategy)

If team persists YC each violation

Ken Sherman asked what if wall refuses to move

Bert said Card them all

John Goonan asked re: who can request 10 yds.

Defending team cannot request 10 yds.

OFFSIDES

A Deflection off a player on defense does not eliminate offsides

TOUCH MUST BE A DELIBERATE ACTION TO PLAY BALL

ONLY EXCEPTION IS IF THERE IS A SHOT "ON FRAME" THAT A KEEPER OR FIELD PLAYER
DEFLECTS BACK TO AN ATTACKER IN AN OFFSIDE POSITION AT THE TIME OF THE SHOT

BALL HANDLERS

LEIGHTON TAYLOR ASKED WHAT TO DO.

IF HOME TEAM LEADING AND INTENTIONALLY KICKING BALL FAR OFF FIELD

Talk to coaches and captains that continued delay will be carded

Report flagrant use of delay to assignors

Rules say Home Team SHALL supply ball handlers

Visitors MAY supply Ball Handlers

If no Ball Retrievers and ball far out of play

Referee may stop clock (After first notifying coaches)

If home team is losing suggested that clock not be stopped
