MINUTES OF MEETING HELD 09/25/17

3rd Meeting of 2017 was called to Order at 7:00 pm by President Joseph Potzka.

Moment of Silence was observed.

Roll Call was taken.

Secretary's Report: The minutes, as posted, for the 09/11/17 meeting were accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Joyce Kaye was not present. The Treasurer's report was read by Pres. Potzka.

There is \$9,019.73 in the operating account.

There is \$4,805.83 in the scholarship account.

There was a motion from the executive board to transfer \$1000.00 from the Operating Account to the Scholarship Account. Seconded and unanimously approved.

INTERPRETER

Follow up to 8/28/17 Questions. On 9/3/17 an email was sent to all officials to answer the questions raised.

Red Card to Coaches: According to MIAA Rules, if a Red Card is issued to a coach or Game Administrator, that individual must leave the field and surrounding areas.

MIAA says that there must be a second coach listed on the roster, a Principal or other adult school official present to replace the Coach. The match is not to be delayed.

A clarification with MIAA says that the delay should be NO MORE THAN 3-5 minutes.

If there is a delay to replace the coach, the game is to be forfeited.

FINALS for all divisions will be Saturday November 18, 2017.

Improper Use of Legal Equipment

First infraction to coach (who has been asked prior to game if players are legally equipped)

Second and subsequent to players. Illegally equipped must be substituted
Improperly equipped may be subbed.

Time issues: Stop clock for goals, PK's, injured players, YC or RC, timeout or at referee's discretion.

Restart clock when BALL is in play NOT on whistle.

Clock to be stopped for all games including Mid. School.

Advantage: Use the SLOW WHISTLE!! Try to wait to see what develops.

Incidental Foul Language: If you hear it deal with it! Too Loud or Too vocal. CAUTION!

Offside: DEFLECTIONS

IF DEFENDER intentionally played ball ATTACKER NOT offside (reset).
IF DEFENDER does NOT intentionally play ball ATTACKER is offside.

Setting wall is not intentional play. Deflection off wall to Attacker IS OFFSIDE.

Defender in wall who jumps, kicks etc. is INTENTIONALLY playing ball so
ATTACKER NOT OFFSIDE.

Noise: In Boys Varsity and Playoffs noise makers NOT ALLOWED. Have home field
authority deal with it.
