Interpreter Report:

Points of emphasis:

We are the "UNIFORM POLICE" according to MIAA.

BEFORE GAME ASK "LEGALLY AND PROPERLY EQUIPPED?"

If player is not, YC to coach, player goes off to address uniform.

NEXT OBSERVATION YC TO PLAYER.

UNIFORM NUMBERS: VARSITY GAMES: One number per player. If two players have same number, one goes off. Coach gets YC.

SUB-Varsity. Use discretion check with coach before game.

GOALKEEPERS: Need numbered jerseys.

Socks: Varsity & JV require matching socks.

Glasses: prescription glasses OK Sports "goggles" flush with face.
No dangerous corners etc. allowed.

ADVANTAGE: Requires signal. Visual or verbal, preferably both.
Please wait a moment before you blow whistle.
Easier to sell call if you are in position near play.

Carl Zopatti raised point that if whistle blown when advantage could have been played. Apologize to coach. If COACH still upset, it his problem!

WARMUP: Visiting team allowed 20 minutes from time they get to bench (not when first player gets off bus) to warm up.

GAME CLOCK MANAGEMENT:

CLOCK STARTS AFTER BALL RETURNS TO PLAY.

WHEN YC OR RC GIVEN YOU CAN STOP CLOCK.

YC/RC: IF ANY TEAM GETS 5 YC OR RC MATCH IS TERMINATED IMMEDIATELY. TEAM WITH CARDS FORFEITS.

FIELD ISSUES: TELL ASSIGNOR

Q & A: When and if should whistle be blown on throw in after substitution?
Always blow whistle after substitution.

DGSO? Is it YC if ball goes into goal and RC if ball stays out?
Correct.
