Open Discussion was held

Tony Del Negro raised the issue of what is to be done when during a PK
The designated kicker stops in approach to ball then kicks ball.

This is Rule 14. The Rule book at page 71 in Art.14.1.4 Situation B discusses the
Four possibilities.

Questions were raised re:

- 1) The length of a JV Game (Coaches determine 35-40 halves)
(Ref. Cannot decide that JV games are 30 minute halves)
- 2) What to do if you find a player improperly equipped after the game starts
(Example: earrings- First the question should have been asked of the coach
Before start of match-YC goes to Coach first, second offense goes to player)
- 3) What is a proper "first touch" of IDK? If One attacker steps on ball (without moving ball) and
second attacker kicks ball. Depends on kicks result: If into goal-score nullified as not proper
second touch. If in play, touch by any player is "second touch".
- 4) What if PK is taken before Lead Ref's whistle? Kick is retaken.
- 5) Handling v. Contact with hand/arm was discussed.
- 6) Diving/Fake Injury was discussed. A scenario that was observed in a match.
An attacker was NOT INJURED but lay on the field and would not get up. A defender stood over
the attacker and was closer to the goal. A ball is sent toward goal by the attacking team at which
point the prone attacker gets up, gets the ball and scores. Ruling NOT OFFSIDE.

How do we handle this situation?

It was raised that as a Ref we are not medical staff and should not be making a determination
about a player's health.

If not injured, the attacker's refusal to get up and play could be deception and cautionable.
The coaches should be spoken to and advised that the prone attacker is not injured but refuses to
get up. Let the coaches decide how to deal with it.
