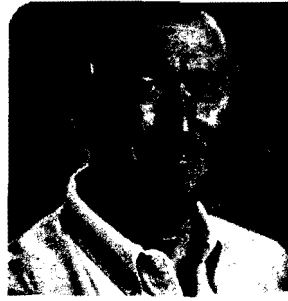
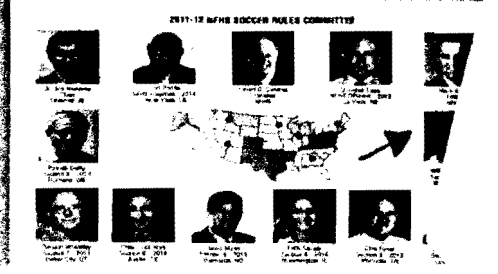

Beginning with the 2012 fall season, the front of the shinguard must be permanently marked with the NOCSAE seal and the height standards for that guard.

Age and size (appropriate) is the key this year.

Misconduct Rule 12-8-1f(12) (new)



... any delayed, excessive or prolonged act(s) by which a player(s) attempts to focus attention upon himself/herself and/or prohibits a timely restart of the game.  
Those exact words were moved from 12-8-2a ("yellow/red disqualification") to 12-8-1f 12 (caution).

Misconduct Rule 12-8-1f(10) and (11) (new)



With no change to the interpretation, an additional two reasons to display a caution card were added under unsporting conduct.

- Player who displays reckless play.
- Illegally equipped player, per 4.3.

### Concussion Recognition and Management

Suggested Guidelines for Management of Concussion

**Concussion Management**  
 Substitutions - Rule 3-3-1c3

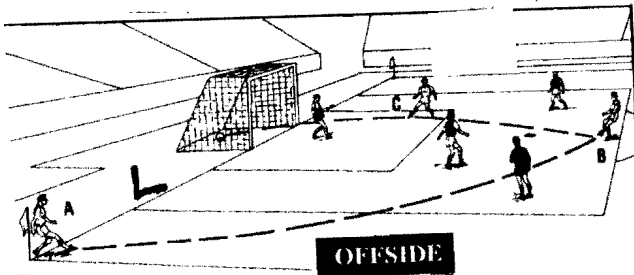
10:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.

Any player who exhibits signs, symptoms, or behaviors consistent with a concussion (such as loss of consciousness, headache, dizziness, confusion, or balance problems) shall be immediately removed from the contest and shall not return to play until cleared by an appropriate health-care professional. (Please see NFHS Suggested Guidelines for Management of Concussion).

## FYI:

- "If they're ready for re-entry. You have to allow them back. Responsibility free! Notice of distress, you may stop play and remove.
- If it was your kid!! (Ah, that's not fair.)
- Doctor's note only for: mask! (for a past injury. Not prevent!)

**SITUATION 5:** Prior to the start of the contest, the referee meets with the teams' head coaches and captains and after reciting a sportsmanship message asks both head coaches if their teams are properly and legally equipped according to NFHS Soccer Rules. Each coach answers in the affirmative. (a) After the contest has started, Player A is noticed to have a shinguard that has the NOCSAE seal indicating that the shinguard is undersized for the player's height; (b) after the second half starts, Player A is noticed to be wearing illegal jewelry; (c) during the course of play, a knee brace is dislodged by a collision between two players. **RULING:** In (a) and (b), if it is the first offense, the player is sent off the field and cannot re-enter until the next legal substitution opportunity, and the coach of Team A is cautioned for the team not being legally equipped. If it is the second offense, the player is cautioned. In (c), player is not cautioned, leaves the field and may re-enter after reporting to an official, who shall be satisfied that the knee brace is now in order. (4-3 Situation A)



→ L (arc then box play.)  
→ T (box play and support/transition!)  
→ L → hustle back into play.

→ Delay whistle! Will be boxed but you will feel good inside.

- Through the MIAA New Rule Proposal process which concluded in June, 2011, a submitted proposal regarding soccer uniforms was reviewed, amended and voted favorably by the Soccer Committee, which would retain the current NFHS Player Equipment Rule 4, Section 1, indefinitely.

**SITUATION 1:** A player who is not listed on the roster scores a goal. The goal is allowed. **RULING:** Legal. Since players may be added to the roster after the start of play, a goal by a player who is not on the roster should be allowed and the player's name and number should be added to the roster. (3-1-3 Situation A)

**77.2.17** Any team whose players/coaches receive collectively five (5) yellow and/or red cards in a match will result in immediate termination of the contest and result in forfeiture by the offending team.

49.2 The athletic director in charge of the contest, or his/her designee, is responsible for: (1) having the official disqualification forms available for game officials, and (2) sending copies to the principal of each school involved, the athletic director of each school involved, and the executive director of the MIAA. Contest official(s) should complete the forms before leaving the site of the contest.

**77.2.18** Game officials must complete the infraction section of the MIAA score sheet for all infractions at all levels. Each school must forward to the MIAA all Girls and Boys VARSITY score sheets where infractions are reported. (Sub-varsity level score sheets should be filed and maintained at the local level).
